She travels well in the car also. She isn't too energetic - has her small bouts of energy where she tears around the yard, but it rarely lasts more than 5 minutes before she needs a sit down.

Generally she's just a lovely quiet dog (doesn't bark at the dogs in the park behind us - has only barked once or twice since she's been in care actually) who loves her company and a good belly rub. I think she'd be suited to pretty much any home, but it would be preferable if they were home more often than not or had another dog as she does like her company. Honey has met many other dogs with zero issues. She's also uninterested in cats so I think a cat house would be fine for her.
